Directions from Joplin, Mo. Take Hwy 43 south to Hwy U. Go west on Hwy U, this turns into Hwy 10C on the OK state line. Go to Hwy 10S, go about 2.4 miles to the campsite on the east side.

From Neosho, Mo- take Hwy 60 west to Hwy 10N. Go 2.5 miles to the driveway to the campsite on the east side of the road.

From Kansa, take Hwy 400 to Baxter Springs. Then take Hwy 69 south to Quapaw, Ok. Take Hwy 137 south out of Quapaw to Hwy 10. Turn east on Hwy 10 until you get to Hwy 10S. Go 2.4 miles to camp on the east side of the road.

TURN IN TO THE DRIVEWAY AND TAKE THE ROAD TO THE RIGHT BETWEEN THE WHITE SHED AND OLD RED BARN. FOLLOW THE SIGNS.
