**As always this is a PRIMITIVE ONLY event. Pre 1840's clothing must be worn at all times after 6 a.m. Tuesday till Sunday a.m.**

**SHOOTING: WED—SAT Rifle, trade gun, pistol, hawk and knife trails**

**Round Robin Trade Blanket—Cannon Shoot—Some Archery**

**Fort Shoot --Novelty Trail walk s—Women's games—Music**

**Sanitation fee: \$25.00 per person for 1 night or the whole week ( Kids 17 and under free)Day use: \$5.00 per person (kids 17 and under free)**

- 1. Period attire is required at all times.**
- 2. Camps must maintain a period appearance at all times.**
- 3. Bring your own water (creek might be dry).**
- 4. Dogs must be kept on leash at all times.**
- 5. No Coleman or gas-powered lights, no hurricane lights, or wind up wick-type lamps (these are not period).**
- 6. Vehicles in designated areas only.**
- 7. Fires must be attended at all times.**
- 8. Must have individual fire permits.**
- 9. You will have two hours to unload after**

**Monday. 10. No greased patches and no single shooters on trail walk. 11. You cannot reserve a space for someone unless you pay the registration for them first and sent up a tent.**
